Germany – which gets more than half of its natural gas, half of its coal, and roughly a third of its oil from Russia – is in talks with the UAE and Qatar to meet its oil and LNG needs. Following a trip to Qatar on Sunday, German Economy Minister Robert Habeck will visit the UAE – one of the world's biggest oil exporters – as Europe's biggest economy seeks to reduce its dependence on Russian energy. Qatar has agreed to work on supplying Germany with liquefied natural gas, while the German government has fast-tracked the construction of two LNG import terminals, a QatarEnergy statement said.
