

Russia's invasion of Ukraine caused a surge in energy prices on Thursday, adding to worries over tight supplies and raising fresh questions about the flows of oil and gas from Russia into Europe in the months ahead. Brent crude broke through the \$100-a-barrel marker after the attack, surging as much as 6 percent to more than \$105 a barrel, its highest point in more than seven years. West Texas Intermediate crude briefly rose above \$100 a barrel.
