"The land transport sector in Lebanon is witnessing a fast growth and is evolving considerably, causing a heavy environmental and economic burden on the government and the population. According to a study published by the Ministry of Environment, the UNDP and IPTEC in 2016, the transport sector counted more than 1.58 million privately-owned vehicles registered in 2012, and was responsible for over 4,350 Gg CO2 emissions in 2011, 1.5 million tons of consumed fuel, and a chronic traffic congestion, which remain on the rise due to the increase in population. the inappropriate
