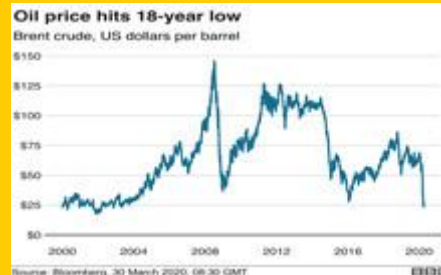

Coronavirus: Oil Price Collapses to Lowest Level for 18 years

The price of oil has sunk to levels not seen since 2002 as demand for crude collapses amid the coronavirus pandemic.

Brent crude fell to \$22.58 (£18.19) a barrel at one point on Monday, its lowest level since November 2002. Meanwhile the price of US West Texas Intermediate (WTI) fell below \$20 a barrel and close to an 18-year low. [Read more](#)
